

## Jubilee: The Ten Commandments

**Theme:** “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.”

**Bible Verse:** “Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates. For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.” (Exodus 20:8-11, ESV)

God established the Sabbath day at creation. For Christians, the Sabbath day is Sunday, the Lord’s Day. Jesus Christ is the Lord of the Sabbath. We should model after Him by worshiping God and doing good on the Sabbath. Our time is a gift from God, with which we should serve and honor Him. We should be good stewards of time and conduct our lives according to a set rhythm - with time for work, time for rest, and time for worship. We should arrange our time appropriately for work, family, study, sleep, exercise, worship, fellowship, scripture reading and prayer, etc. We should use it to share the gospel urgently in these last days and not waste it on fleeting pleasures.

### REFLECTION:

- Are we intentionally keeping the Sabbath regularly and spending intimate time with God on the Sabbath?

### RENEWAL:

- If we failed to manage time wisely, ask the Lord to change us and teach us to be good stewards.
- Use time judiciously and share the gospel at every opportunity.

### PRAYER REQUESTS:

- Church members will worship regularly and become good stewards of time.
- For the church -
  - Brothers and sisters attend Sunday worship and fellowship regularly.
  - Have time management for effective evangelism.
  - Those in pain or sickness and waiting for employment will have hope, peace, and joy in the Lord.
- For the Kingdom -
  - Missionaries follow the Great Commission and advance the Kingdom to the whole world.
